STEPHEN'S STORY AND THE REASON FOR THE TUNNEL TO TOWERS GOLF EVENTS

On Sept. 11, 2001, Stephen Siller, a 34 year old firefighter, took his final heroic steps as he ran with his gear through the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel to the World Trade Center to help save others. Thousands of lives were saved that day, but this was not Stephen's destiny. The NYC 5K RUN & WALK traces the footsteps that he took on that fateful day. In running along his path, the 17th annual run on September 30th not only honors Stephen, but also his 342 firefighter brothers and sisters along with all others who perished on 9/11.

On that tragic summer's day, 9/11/01, Stephen had just completed his scheduled tour with the FDNY and was traveling to meet his brothers to play a traditional round of GOLF. However, when he heard the scanner in his truck, he decided to go back and help. Unfortunately Stephen and the innocence of an entire nation died that day. Stephen was so close to his brothers, they played golf together as often as possible. As a tribute to Stephen and others who made the ultimate sacrifice, we will soon have five golf events. The Grand-Daddy on 3 courses on Staten Island, NY; in Central New Jersey; Ft. Myers, Florida; Dallas, Texas and in Orchard Park, NY.



HERO-TO-HERO HONOREE MARGARET WALIER SEELIGER

On Sept. 11, 2001, Margaret Walier Seeliger gave up her place on a crowded elevator leaving the 100th floor of 2 World Trade Center to two colleagues, an act of generosity that would not have surprised anyone that knew her. Worrying about others was her way. Margaret, 34, worked as head of the student health division for Aon Insurance. She graduated from Stony Brook University in 1992 with a BS in Applied Math and Statistics and married Bruce Seeliger.

Margaret, her seven brothers and sisters grew up in Lakeview, NY and attended Frontier High School. Margaret had boundless energy and lived her life to the fullest. She felt and often stated that "you never know how long you have here on earth" so she was always busy. Many of her weekends were spent traveling to Buffalo visiting with her mom, who had fallen victim to Alzheimer's. Margaret was a very important part of her mom's care, attending to even the smallest details for her.



HERO-TO-HERO HONOREE RUSSELL SALVATORE

Russell Salvatore is a native of Buffalo, NY and a US Army Veteran. He is a successful business entrepreneur whose holdings include Salvatore's Grand Hotel and Russell's Steakhouse. His philanthropic efforts over the course of decades are legendary in the Buffalo Community.

He also created Patriots and Heroes Park as a remembrance to those lost on 9/11. It also shows deep appreciation for our Veterans, First Responders and honors those lost on Flight 3407. This park has become a treasure for Western New York.

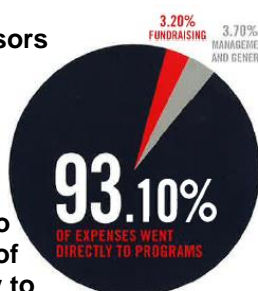
