
#### **DIRECTIONS TO THE PAVILION**



The Pavilion is located behind the Orchard Park Middle School on Lincoln Avenue. There is parking at the Middle School, as well as the on the side streets around the Pavilion, and behind the Municipal Building on South Buffalo Street, which is only 1 block away. Access for persons with disabilities is by way of the driveway that runs along the north side of the Pavilion.
